Title

Methods in philosophy

Course Description

The course aims at presenting some of the main methodologies used in contemporary philosophy and in the history of philosophy. After presenting the method of mental experiments, which dates back to early analytic philosophy, students will study the “genalogic” method and deconstruction, which is much developed in continental philosophy. Eventually they will give some information on contemporary method in the studies in the history of Philosophy.

Course organization

The course will be organized in lectures organized during an entire afternoon, with a short break between two parts of the lesson.
