Course Description

Each class of the seminar will be devoted to the in-depth discussion of a dissertation chapter by one of the 2nd year and 3rd year FINO PhD students of the Theoretical curriculum. Participants will provide materials helpful to the discussion (summaries, synopses, handout or other) at least one week in advance.

Each seminar's meeting will include a presentation by the speaker, which is then followed by a debate directed by the Seminar's organizer, during which participants are invited to address to the speaker remarks and comments on both methodological and substantive aspects of her/his research.
