The course is open to all Curricula, but it is mainly intended for PhD students of Theoretical Curriculum and is mandatory for cycles 35 and 36

Title:

*Philosophy and Religion: God as the object of philosophy.
Speculative interpretations of the doctrine of Holy Trinity in the idealistic field and its up-to-date readings.*

Course Description:

Philosophy has no other object but God, Hegel thought. This statement can hardly be endorsed today. Or can it?

Course organization:

The course is divided into two modules (in presence or remote): the first module (4 hours), aims to present some crucial moments of the idealistic reflection on God the Trinity (frontal lesson). The second module (2 hours), consists in the discussion of a paper on the logic of adding.

Basic-intermediate knowledge of theological language and Christian philosophy.
